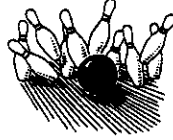

'M A T C H P L A Y'

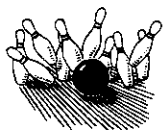
Hosted by: Music City Senate of TNBA
(April 2010 – Rules/Guidelines)

1. Matchplay is a friendship, fellowship, and sportsmanship TNBA tournament held in April and July of each year (unless there is a problem securing the lanes). This Matchplay will consist of bowlers from the following Senates: Derbytown, River City, Music City, Bluegrass, plus invited guests.
2. All participants must be USBC and TNBA cardholders. Any participant not in good standing with his/her Senate as reported by their president or officer representative will not be allowed to bowl.
3. Breakdown of entry fees per person is as follows. The prize list is based on entries with a prize ratio of at least 1:10. Prizes will be paid per game and series.

4. Bowling Format: Teams will consist of any two bowlers. Partners and lane assignments will be randomly selected prior to bowling (blind draw). Bowlers must bowl with partner paired with and on the lanes assigned or they will not be allowed to bowl (no refunds). Each bowler will roll five games on the same pair of lanes. A portion of the prize fund (up to 20%) may be paid for the individual and scratch awards.
5. Verification of average is required. Acceptable forms of verification include average yearbook, letter, or form signed by the association secretary (league secretary valid for current averages only). Bowlers will use their highest 2008-2009 book average (21 games minimum). If a bowler does not have a 2008-2009 book average, he/she may use current average (21 games minimum) as of April 15, 2010. Sanctioned 2009 summer average may be accepted (21 game minimum) if no other average. If a bowler does not have a book, current, or summer average (and proper verification), he/she must bowl scratch (225).
6. It is the bowler's responsibility to verify his/her average. **The ten-pin rule shall apply.** USBC Rules 319a (Average – Conditions that Apply), 319b (Assigned Averages), 319c (Rerating), Rule 319d (Reporting Prior Prize Winnings), and 319e (Average Adjustments) shall apply.
7. The use of substance such as talcum powder, rosin, etc. on shoes is strictly prohibited. If a bowler has problems with the approach, contact the control center.
8. Handicap will be based on 90% of 225.
9. There will be music during Matchplay if available.
10. No personal checks. Make cashier's checks/money orders payable to: TNBA Music City Senate.
11. Bowling shall begin in accordance with a previously arranged schedule. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame bowled (a zero will be given for all missed frames).
12. Automatic scorers will be used. In the event of equipment failure, tournament officials reserve the right to move individuals/teams to a different pair of lanes. Be sure to check your score.
13. Entry fee is \$45 per person for entries postmarked by 4/16/2010. Late entries will be accepted through 4/23/2010 at 11PM. The late entry fee is \$50 per person (the \$5 will be added to expenses).
14. Rule 314 (No Fees Returned) shall apply. In case of no-show or inability to bowl, substitutions may be allowed. Note: the tournament director is not required to reimburse the original entrant. In case of an injury or inability to bowl, prize winnings will be paid to the substitute/replacement bowler in accordance with USBC rules and Rule 324b (Substitutions during Game or Series).
15. The tournament committee in accordance with USBC guidelines shall resolve any rule not covered within. Their ruling shall be final.
