# 3RD ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Eligibility—Tournament is open to all bowlers who have a minimum of 32 games in the 2009–2010 Tusculum Youth League.
2. Format—Entrants will bowl 3 games in the qualifying round. 100% of the difference between the bowlers league average as of 3/6/10 and 200 will be added to each game. The top 5 bowlers will advance to the scholarship step-ladder finals where 5 vs 4, winner vs 3, winner vs 2, etc.
3. Entry Fee/Deadline—Entry fee is \$10.00. If paying by check, make payable to Tusculum Lanes. Entries accepted until time of tournament.
4. Ties—If tie for seeds 1–3, tie will be broken by a draw. If tie for 4th seed, there will be a handicap 9th and 10th frame roll-off. If tie for 5th seed, scholarship award of \$100.00 will be divided equally.
5. Qualifying Awards—After step-ladder finals, \$1500.00 in scholarships will be awarded as listed on front of entry form.
6. Awards for Non-Scholarship Winners—\$50.00 gift certificates from Jenxxx Pro Shop will be awarded to bowlers having highest handicap game in each of the 3 qualifying games. Only a non-scholarship winner is eligible for the pro shop certificates. Bowler can win only one certificate.
7. Late Bowlers—Tournament will be begin promptly at 1PM. Bowlers arriving late may enter game in progress, but will get no pins for frames missed. No entry fees will be refunded due to late arrival.
8. Utilization of Scholarship Funds—Scholarship funds must be used within three calendar years of the year of your graduation from high school.
9. Non-Sanctioned Tournament—This tournament will not be sanctioned through the United States Bowling Congress, but its rules will prevail. Any dispute not covered by these rules will be decided upon by the tournament director and committee. Their decision shall be final.
